Language Arts

We will be reading the story, "Arthur's Reading Race," by Marc Brown. Our comprehension skills will focus on identifying the characters in a story and analyzing the characters' traits.

Spelling and Phonics

Our phonics skills for the week will be the short vowels /a/a, /i/i and the CVC Pattern in longer words. Some examples of our spelling words are flag, fin, ran, has, fill, and sat. The spelling test will be on Friday.

Math

We will be finishing Chapter 1-Numbers to 100. The students have modeled and identified tens and ones in two-digit numbers to 99 and represented numbers in a variety of equivalent forms. In Chapter 2 we will discuss number patterns such as skip-counting, and model even and odd numbers.

Social Studies

We will identify and describe functions of government and understand how government works to help citizens.
